
CONFIGURE ANONYMOUS AUTHENTICATION

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Overview

The Portal Splash Page/Anonymous Authentication feature eliminates the need to configure Guest Templates, Sponsors for guests and Guest Accounts. The Captive Portal page may contain an Acceptable Use Policy and guests must indicate that they agree before being granted access to the Production network. Using this option, guests do not register using credentials. Hosts are registered as devices, are displayed in Host view and are not associated with any user.

Using the Portal Splash Page or anonymous authentication eliminates the need to configure Guest Templates, Sponsors for guests and Guest Accounts.

Note: Anonymous authentication is not supported with a portal configured with Host Inventory used as the success page type.

WARNING: If you switch from Full Guest Management to Portal Splash Page, existing settings for Full Guest Management will be lost, guests will not be asked for login credentials and guests may be asked to agree to your Acceptable Use Policy.

Procedure

Configure the Portal Page

1. Navigate to **System > Portal Configuration**.
2. Click on the Content Editor tab.
3. If you have created more than one portal, click the drop-down list arrow at the bottom of the view.
4. Select the portal to be edited from.
5. If this will be a separate portal, click **Create New Portal Configuration**.
6. Click the "+" next to **Registration** in the left hand pane to expand.
7. Click **Anonymous Authentication**. The properties for that page are displayed in the right pane.
8. Modify the properties as needed. Click the ? next to each property for details.
9. Click **APPLY** to save changes or navigate to another step to abandon them.

To view the page, use the following URL:

http(s)://<FortiNAC Server or Application Server FQDN>/registration/AnonymousAuth.jsp

If using multiple portals, add the following to the end of the URL:

?portalName=<portal name>

Note when changes are made to the portal pages, there is a delay before the changes are displayed.

Make the Portal Page Visible in the Login Menu

The Login Menu is the page displayed when a client is re-directed to the Captive Portal upon isolation.

1. Under **Registration**, click **Login Menu**.
2. Click the checkbox next to **Anonymous Authentication Enabled**.
3. Edit the Anonymous Authentication properties as desired. Click the "?" next to each property for details.
4. Click **APPLY** in the bottom left of the window to save changes.

To view the page, use the appropriate URL:

If the Acceptable Use Policy is enabled the Global Settings section:

http(s)://<FortiNAC Server or Application Server FQDN>/registration/LoginMenu.jsp

Otherwise, it is:

http(s)://<FortiNAC Server or Application Server FQDN>/registration/index-registration.jsp

If using multiple portals, add the following to the end of the URL:

?portalName=<portal name>

Configure Portal Policy (if Applicable)

If the new Anonymous Registration page is a separate portal from other portals, a Portal Policy will be needed in order to ensure the correct portal displays when clients are isolated.

1. Navigate to **Policy > Policy Configuration**.
2. Click **Portal** on the left hand side of the window.
3. Click **Add**.
4. Select the appropriate User/Host Profile (or create a new profile by clicking the page icon with the +).
5. Select the new portal configuration from the drop-down menu.
6. Click **OK**.
7. If there are existing policies, the newly added policy will be listed last in rank. Set the rank appropriately.
