

HIDE DOWNLOAD BUTTON IN CAPTIVE PORTAL

What it Does

The following steps hide the **Download** button in the desired portal page. The **Download** button allows a user to download an agent to their machine (if it matches a particular Endpoint Compliance Policy).


How it Works

The change is made using the Style Editor in the FortiNAC Administrative UI. The Style Editor within the Portal Configuration provides the ability to modify the look and feel of the portal pages.

Note: Changes made in the Style Editor only apply to its associated portal (listed at the bottom left corner of the Portal Configuration view). To make changes in a different portal, select the desired portal from the drop-down menu.

Procedure

1. In the FortiNAC Administrative UI, navigate to **System > Portal Configuration**.
2. If multiple portals are used, select the appropriate portal from the drop-down menu at the bottom left corner of the view.
3. Expand **Global** and click **Styles**.
4. Scroll down to the bottom of the page (Custom Rules Definitions section).
5. Click **ADD RULE**.

6. Populate the **ENTER SELECTOR** field with the appropriate entry from the table on the next page. This selector value defines which portal page the button will be hidden.

Portal Page	Selector
Registration	.registration #applyBtn
Remediation	.remediation #applyBtn
VPN	.vpn #applyBtn
Authentication	.authentication #applyBtn
Hub	.hub #applyBtn

7. Within the box, click **ADD PROPERTY**.
8. Type **display** for the property and **none** for the value.

9. Click **Apply** at the bottom of the view.
10. If already accessing the portal page during this change, refresh the page to view changes.

If the rule is no longer desired, click **Remove Rule** and **Apply**.
